Old Business

#3. Refurbish the scoreboard on football field. Funds are set aside for this project \$1000. It has not been completed at this time. Katy said she would check on this.

Maria made the motion to pay \$50 to the group/organization that signed up and showed up to help but they would need to stay the entire allotted time they are scheduled. At least one adult will need to be present to oversee students. Renae seconded. AIF.

Tiz will write up a description of duties that will be expected for the concession help.

We will sell pop and water in concessions stands as well as having the pop machines available.

Katy asked Kari what needs to be purchased to get concessions started. Kari said everything. We are not stocked up at this time. Annette said she is going to Bend on the 5th and would be willing to pick up any items that we need. Kari offered to contact Cash and Carry and have the entire order ready for pick up and Annette would just need to stop and get supplies. Kari said she would get back to Annette if this plan was going to work.

Membership

We need to get the word out what CUHS Booster club does and why we do it. Booster Club should all be very proud of the goals we met and the accomplishments for 2017-18 school year. It is rewarding to have an active Booster Club and see results.
